

Physicals, Immunizations, Eye, and Dental Information

In order to be state compliant, all of our students need to be up to date with their physical, immunizations, eye, and dental examination by the first day of school.

~ Physicals and Immunizations

Students entering preschool, kindergarten, and sixth grade, in the fall, are required to have an updated physical and updated immunizations. **When entering these grades, your child's physical cannot be older than six months.**

- † Physical / Immunization Form (yellow form) – is available in the main office.
- † The Academy does not recommend the Gardasil vaccine for young girls.



~ Dental Examination

Students entering kindergarten, second, and sixth grade, in the fall, are required to have an updated dental examination.

- † The Dental Examination Form (yellow form) – is available in the main office.



~ Eye Examination

Students entering kindergarten in the fall and all kindergarten - 8th grade transfer students are required to have an updated eye examination.

- † The Eye Examination Form (yellow form) – is available in the main office.

~ Preschool Requirements

- † Up to date on all infant shots
- † Physical examination
- † Varicella immunization or verification date of having the Chicken Pox

~ Kindergarten Requirements

- † 5th DPT shot
- † 4th OPV shot
- † 2nd MMR shot
- † Varicella immunization or verification date of having the Chicken Pox
- † Dental examination
- † Eye examination

~ Second Grade Requirements

- † Dental examination

~ Sixth Grade Requirements

- † A physical examination
- † Three doses of the Hepatitis B shot. *The doses are given at different intervals and should be started the spring before entering 6th grade.*
